Digital content is compatible on *all* major devices – whether provided by the district or personally owned by the student – and can be used online or offline

Time spent reading positively impacts reading proficiency & achievement

Long-term impact of reading:

Reading 30 minutes vs. 15 minutes per day leads to 12 million more vocabulary words learned over the course of a student's schooling. Reading had a higher level of correlation to achievement than socioeconomic status, gender, family structure, or even time spent on homework (PISA)

Why go digital?

- Most schools staffed with school librarian- access to print materials but few digital materials
- Digital platform aligned to our public library- one platform
- Students are one to one with Chromebooks
- Impactful data on student reading habits
- Platform provides built in accessibility tools that benefit all learners
- Maximizing purchasing power for district-wide access

Our Starting Point

- Started with basic set up and OverDrive provided materials
- Added Battle of the Books titles for district-wide access
- Librarians provided feedback for additional high interest, high instructional value titles

Using Data for Advocacy



- Data on Average Time Per Book By Format shows more time in text with audiobooks
