

The Sora app makes reading accessible for your students



READING PERSONALIZATION

Sora offers ebook customization settings like adjustable font typefaces and sizes (including dyslexic font), and different screen lighting options. Plus, students can personalize their audiobook and read-along experience by adjusting the narration playback speed.

HIGH CONTRAST

High contrast mode is also available in Sora's interface and in its ebooks. For those with low vision, high contrast options can improve readability and app navigation.

READ TO ME

This feature for text-to-speech support allows students to select any word, phrase, sentence or paragraph in an ebook and then choose Read to Me to hear the selected text read aloud. Students can also opt to hear pronunciations for the words they define while reading and everywhere else they see defined words in Sora.

SCREEN READER SUPPORT

We follow WCAG guidelines to make Sora accessible. This includes skip links, alt text, labeled elements, logical tabbing order, and much more.

Sora should work with most screen readers, but we test on:

- Android Accessibility Suite
- ChromeVox
- JAWS

- NVDA
- VoiceOver

Students using a screen reader to navigate Sora can enter Read From Here mode after opening an ebook to hear the text read aloud.
