


Reading settings in OverDrive Read






Reading settings in the app

Adjust the font size, font style, or color scheme to make text easier to read.







Font size


Color scheme

Dyslexic font




Digital library display options

The site will automatically update when you select a display option.






Navigating your digital library

Users who rely on a keyboard can also use the tab key navigate the website.

Skip links allow users to skip past the header to the main content or footer.

Screen readers

- Screen readers are software applications that allow blind and visually impaired users to read the content on their screen.
- Users will be able to hear the text spoken or read it with a Braille display.
- Screen readers can be used to:
 - Find and borrow titles from your digital library.
 - Navigate the OverDrive app.
 - Browse and search resources on OverDrive Help.

- Easiest way to enjoy titles
- Download MP3 audiobooks
- Compatible with:
 - OverDrive app (Android, iOS, and Windows 8)
 - OverDrive for Windows
 - OverDrive for Mac

eBooks



- Download EPUB eBooks or Kindle Books (U.S. only)
- Compatible with:
 - Adobe Digital Editions (2.0 or newer)
 - Kindle for PC with Accessibility Plugin
 - Kindle app (Android and iOS)



Popular screen readers*

- JAWS (Job Access with Speech)
 - Available for Windows.
- **NVDA (NonVisual Desktop Access)**
 - Available for Windows.
- **Window-Eyes for Windows**
 - Available for Windows.
- **ZoomText**
 - Available for Windows and Mac.
- VoiceOver for Mac and iOS
 - Built into Mac and iOS devices.
- Google TalkBack for Android
 - Pre-installed on most Android devices.
