

Saving Jacket Covers for Canva Templates

To ensure consistency of the image quality and size, we recommend saving jacket covers from your collection websites. Here is how:

To save jackets from **Libbyapp.com**:

1. Visit libbyapp.com in a web browser.
2. If you are not already signed in, find your library and enter your library card and pin.
3. Search for a book and click on the jacket cover to view the title details.
4. Click the share button at the top of the title details page.
 - a. *It's important to save jacket covers Libby's share link to ensure the file type is .JPG. Saving jackets directly from libbyapp.com will save a WEBP file which will not work in Canva.*
 - b. *Some web browsers, like Firefox, will open the share link automatically in a new tab. Other web browsers, like Google Chrome, may require you to copy the share link and then paste it into a new tab manually. Share links will always have "share" in the URL, like [this example](#).*
5. From the share webpage, right click the jacket cover and save.

To save jackets from **Kanopy.com**:

1. Visit Kanopy.com in a web browser.
 - a. *We recommend Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge. Mozilla Firefox is not recommended for this task, as right clicking a jacket cover in Firefox does not give the option to save images.*
2. If you are not already signed in, find your library and create an account.
3. Search for a movie and click on "see more" to view the title details.
4. Right click the jacket cover and save.
