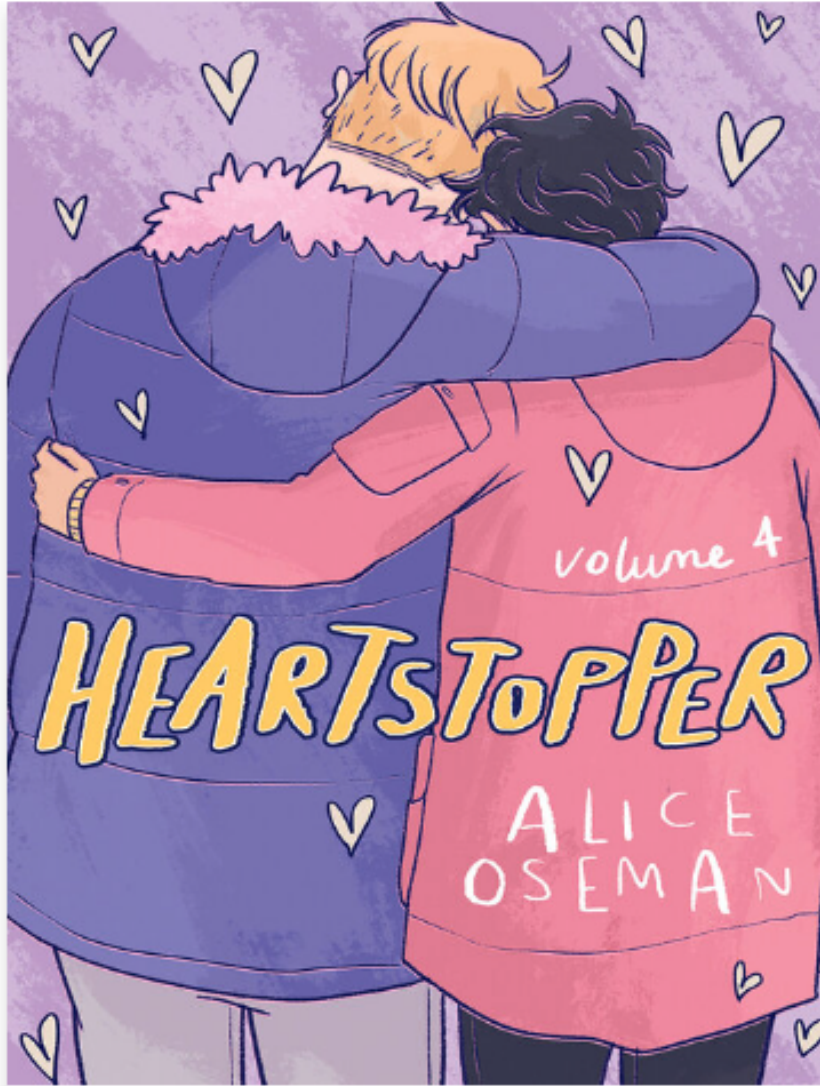

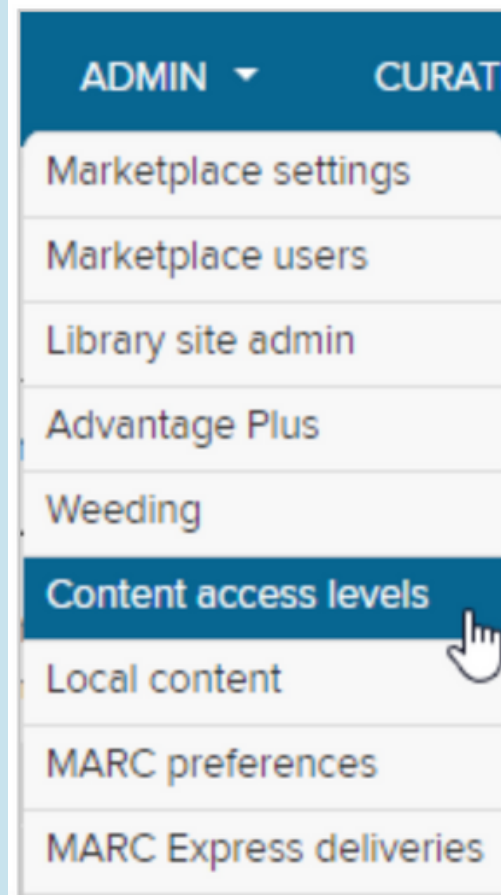
Content Access Levels

How to enable content access levels

[Content access levels](#) let you control which types of users can view and borrow certain titles in your digital collection.

Before you can [assign content access levels to titles](#), you'll need to contact your Account Manager (whose contact information is listed under the Marketplace Support tab) to enable the tool and set [default access levels](#) for your site.

Once the tool is enabled, staff members will need the "Content access levels" permission to access Content access levels from the Admin tab. [Learn more about editing Marketplace user permissions](#).



Weeding

Automatic weeding plan

Titles must meet all of your specified criteria to be automatically weeded. For example, if you set your plan to weed expired titles and titles without holds, titles must be both expired and have no holds to be weeded.

Note:: Your plan will run daily and hide eligible titles within 24 hours.

To restore a weeded title to your collection, go to [Search collection](#) to find and unweed it. Please note your plan will automatically weed titles again if they meet the plan's criteria.
