






New filters simplify finding the right book

Sora's latest update streamlines the filtering process, helping students more easily find the right content in the digital collection. Both Filters and Preferences are now part of one cohesive experience, accessible from the top right Filters menu on any page within the Explore tab.



Sora's updated Filters menu lets students refine the collection making it easier to get to the types of books they like. Students can filter for read-alongs, comics and graphic novels or even specific formats like audiobooks. They can also filter by subjects of interest, content in other languages, and more. Additionally, filters are now **sticky**: once a filter is set, it will apply to all displayed content until you remove it. To remove or adjust applied filters, return to the Filters menu, or simply deselect the filter from the top of the page. Click on the FILTERs button in the upper left corner to set your






For Elementary / Middle School (6-8)




For Elementary School (K-5)

Don't miss the sixth picture book in the #1 New York Times bestselling Food Group series that's ripe with humor from Jory John and Pete Oswald!










Top 10 Titles by Checkouts – October 1 – 31, 2022
