

Getting started with

Kindle® ereaders

You can borrow Kindle Books (U.S. only) from your library and deliver them wirelessly to your Kindle e-reader.

NOTE: If you have a Fire tablet, you may be able to use the Libby app or the OverDrive app to borrow and download ebooks directly to your device. For more help, visit help.overdrive.com.

STEP 1

Find your library's digital collection using overdrive.com/libraries.

STEP 2

In your library's digital collection, borrow an ebook that's available in the **Kindle Book** format.

STEP 3

Select **Read now with Kindle** for the borrowed ebook. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

STEP 4

Follow the on-screen prompts to **Get library book** and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle e-reader. You'll need to sign into (or create) an Amazon account to complete this process.

NOTE: Your Kindle e-reader needs a Wi-Fi internet connection to download library Kindle Books from Amazon. If you aren't connected to Wi-Fi, you'll need to transfer Kindle Books to your Kindle e-reader via USB.

Once you deliver a library Kindle Book to your Kindle e-reader, it works like any other Kindle Book.
