
The Summer Slide

Children lose significant knowledge in reading


3rd to 5th graders lost, on average, about 20 percent of their school-year gains in reading







K-1 students are introduced to small features of SORA that include:

- How to borrow and open a book to read
- How to listen to an audiobook


2nd-3rd grade students are introduced to more features of SORA that include:

- How to return a book after they are done reading it
- How to put a book on hold
- How to earn badges by completing missions

4th - 5th grade students are introduced to more advanced features of SORA that include:

- How to create a wishlist
- How to bookmark a page

Time(s) of year: Students in all grade levels learn SORA about 2-3 times per year.
