



## Sora Setup & Implementation (June 2018)

- ✓ Trained librarians in August
- ✓ Used Destiny to log in
  - MARC records integrated into Destiny
  - OverDrive accessed directly through title records in Destiny
- ✓ Students taught OverDrive as they received their 1:1 device in 8<sup>th</sup> grade
- ✓ District-wide collection & Advantage Accounts for each building
  - Student access to District Collection & their school's Advantage Account
  - Teachers have access to District Collection & All Advantage Accounts
  - Only way to ILL ebooks and audiobooks





## Sora Setup & Implementation (Fall of 2019)







Stopped putting records in Destiny


Changed to the Google Login

Kept Destiny for print materials / OverDrive for ebooks and audiobooks

- Less confusing for user
- Not sure if it was a Follett ebook or OverDrive ebook (icons were so similar in Destiny)
- Sora would not link to Destiny



## Sora Setup & Implementation (Elementary Schools)



- **✓** Rolled out iPads with elementary students
- ✓ Librarians are digital learning instructional leaders
  - Lead the training for teachers on use of digital tools for learning
  - Perfect segue into use of digital books and audiobooks
  - Elementary students were so excited to get device, eager to use digital books
- ✓ Access through a Single Sign-On Portal

### OverDrive systems help to manage collection

Audiobooks: 612

### Librarians email recommended purchases

- End of metered access
- Student requests
- Creation of carts by request
- Book lists
- Numbers of copies recommended


Breakdown of audiobook vs. ebook checkouts



## Collection Management (Linked to Public Library)





### **Spring of 2020: Linked to Omaha Public Library**

- ✓ Students have access to the OPL Collection without having a library card
- ✓ Accounts are filtered based on our access level settings
  - Elementary Juvenile
  - Middle School YA and Juvenile
  - High School Adult, YA, and Juvenile
- **✓ OPL** gets circulation credit for their books
- MPS gets circulation credit for our collections
- **✓** User knows if they are checking it out from OPL or MPS



## Collection Management (Budget)



Can't keep up with the demand

Added money to my planned spending every year

When asked about adding money for books, a colleague said, "Students are demanding it."

Most budget is spent keeping what we have (Metered Access is hard on a budget)

### 2020-2021 School Year Usage:

- **✓ Ebook Checkouts:** 126,786
- **✓ Audiobook Checkouts:** 19,816
- ✓ Users: 8,092
- ✓ Holds: 51,112
- ✓ Top 10 Buildings in last 12 months (36 buildings total using):
  - 5 Middle Schools
  - 5 Elementary Schools
