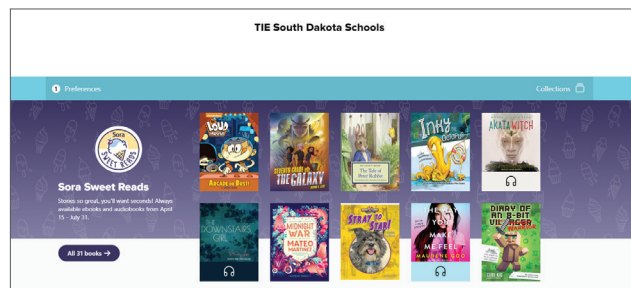
Expand access to digital resources

What is a shared collection?

A shared collection enables two or more schools or districts to access digital content via a joint platform. Purchased titles are available to all participating schools or districts through this central access point.

Why join?

If School A were to initiate a digital collection of their own, they may only be able to afford 50 titles. However, by joining a collection shared by 20 schools or districts, School A would have access to 1,000 titles. This shared collection grows year after year and as more schools or districts join.

How do I get started?

- Partner with neighboring schools or districts to start a shared collection or join an existing one in your region
- All purchased titles are available to all members of the shared collection via the Sora app or the Sora browser version
- In addition, students can directly access OverDrive digital content through their local public library through Sora

Additional benefits include:

- The ability to add titles specifically for your school or district (separate from the shared collection)
- Titles filtered by grade level to ensure the right titles are reaching the right students
- Implementation team to assist you with setup, training, and content selection
