

Using Libby with an ereader

You can download Libby ebooks on a computer, then use free Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) software to transfer them to Adobe-compatible ereaders.

Note: If you have a Kindle or Kobo ereader, ask a library staff member for the guide for those devices.

On a computer, visit libbyapp.com. Follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.

Borrow an ebook that supports EPUB or PDF format.

Tip: Check which formats an ebook supports by clicking the book cover and scrolling down to the “Read With...” section of the title details page.

Go to your **Shelf** , then select **Read With...** next to an ebook.
