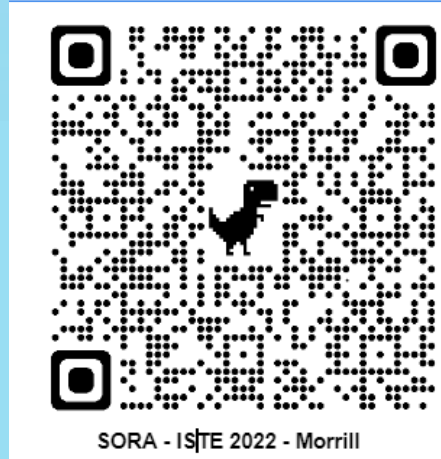

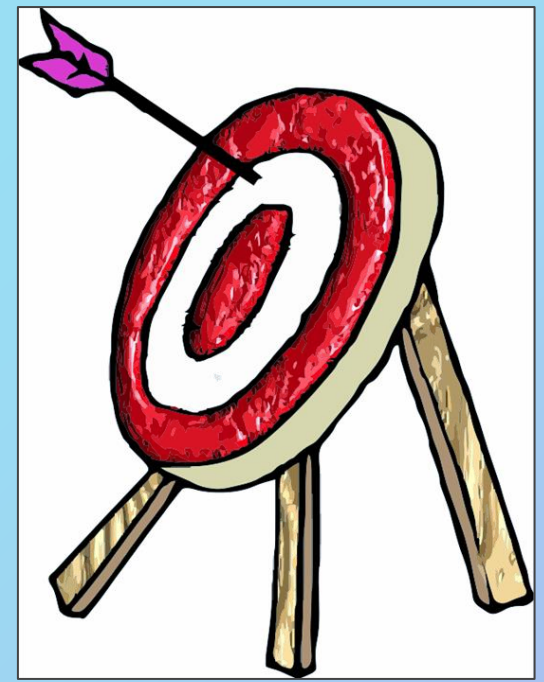

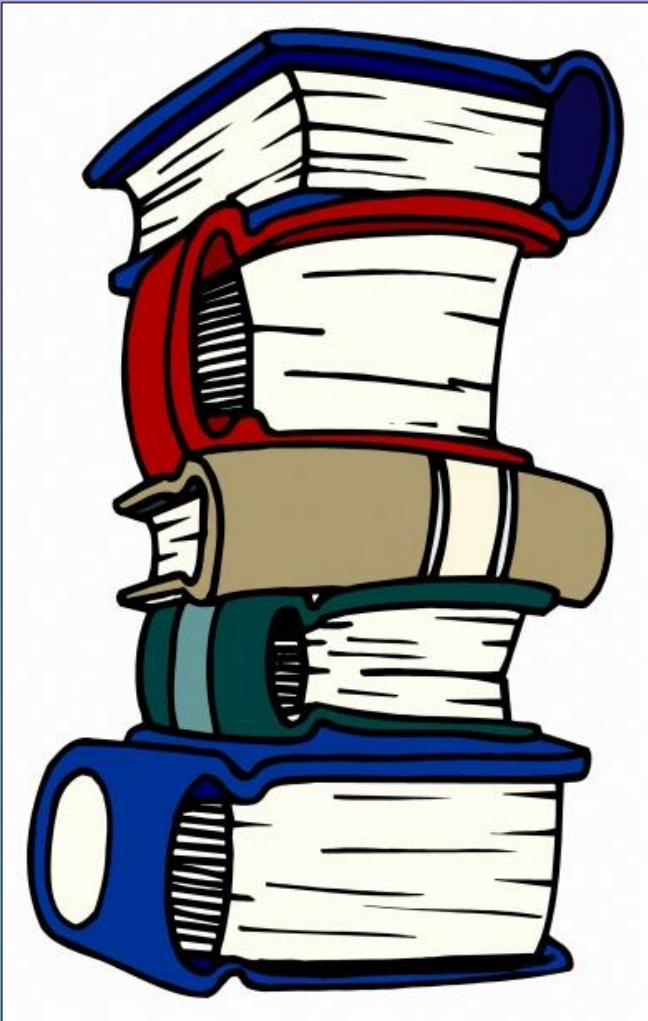

Content Bundles:

Like a Book List but
limited to
YOU and YOUR STUDENTS



Content Bundles for inside & outside the classroom.

Reserve and bundle content to build:



- Classroom libraries
- Curriculum libraries
- Topic or theme sets
- Multi-book assignments
- Virtual "book bins"
- Special collections only available to a specific grade, class, book club, etc.
- Teacher or professional development collections





Bundles allow you to...

- maximize classroom time
- ensure titles are available to YOUR students
 - provide consistency in level planning
 - save planning time

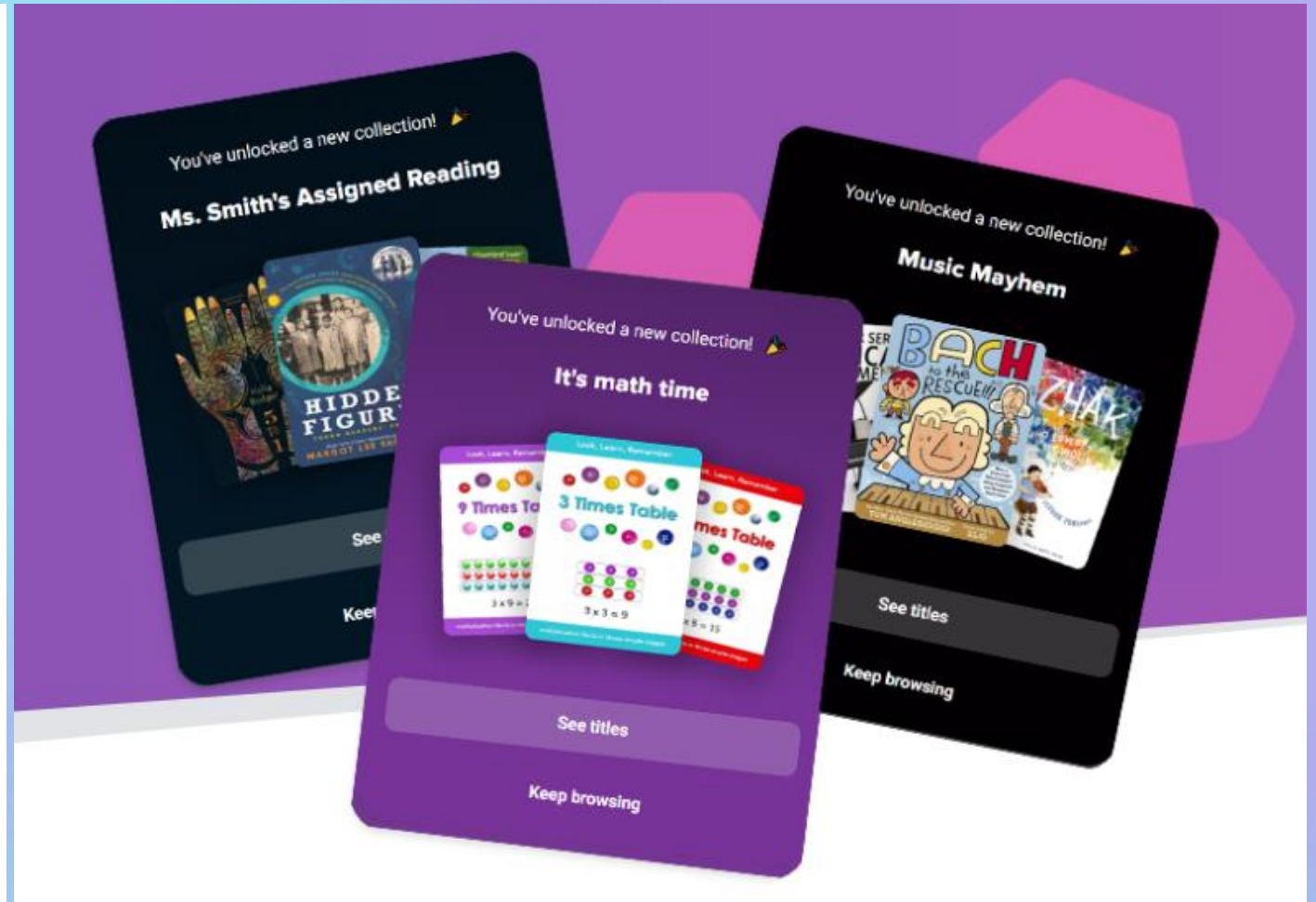
Bundles allow you to avoid...

- the "I can't find a book."
- the "I don't know what to read."



How does it work?

- 1** Reserve titles
to remove them from the main collection.
- 2** Create bundles
from your pool of reserved titles.
- 3** Claim bundles
to receive the Sora access code.
- 4** Share access code with students
to let them unlock books in Sora.

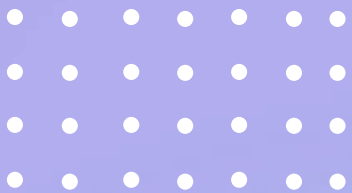

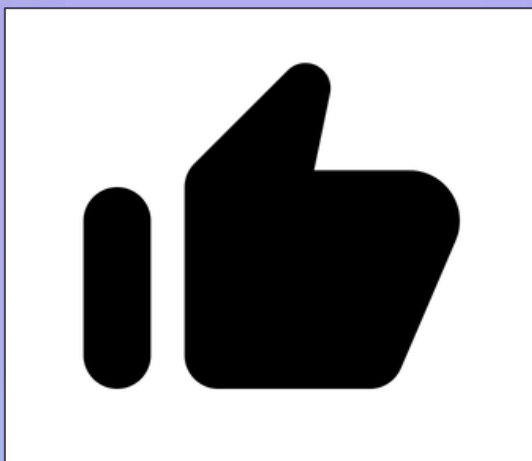

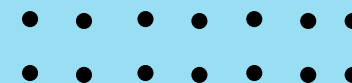


Simultaneous-use Magazines and Comics Benefits:

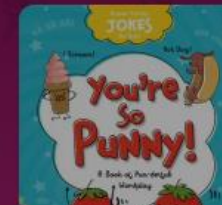

In-app public library access

How to add a library

You can use Sora to browse your library and borrow books with your library card.

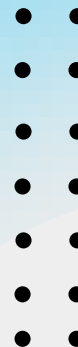
Note: The type of account you have may limit the library books you see in Sora.

To add your library:

1. Click or tap  .
2. Select **Add library**.
3. Use the search box to find your library, then select **This is my library**. The library will open in the **Explore** tab.

To switch between libraries, select a library from the menu or from the drop-down at the top of the **Explore** tab.

- 

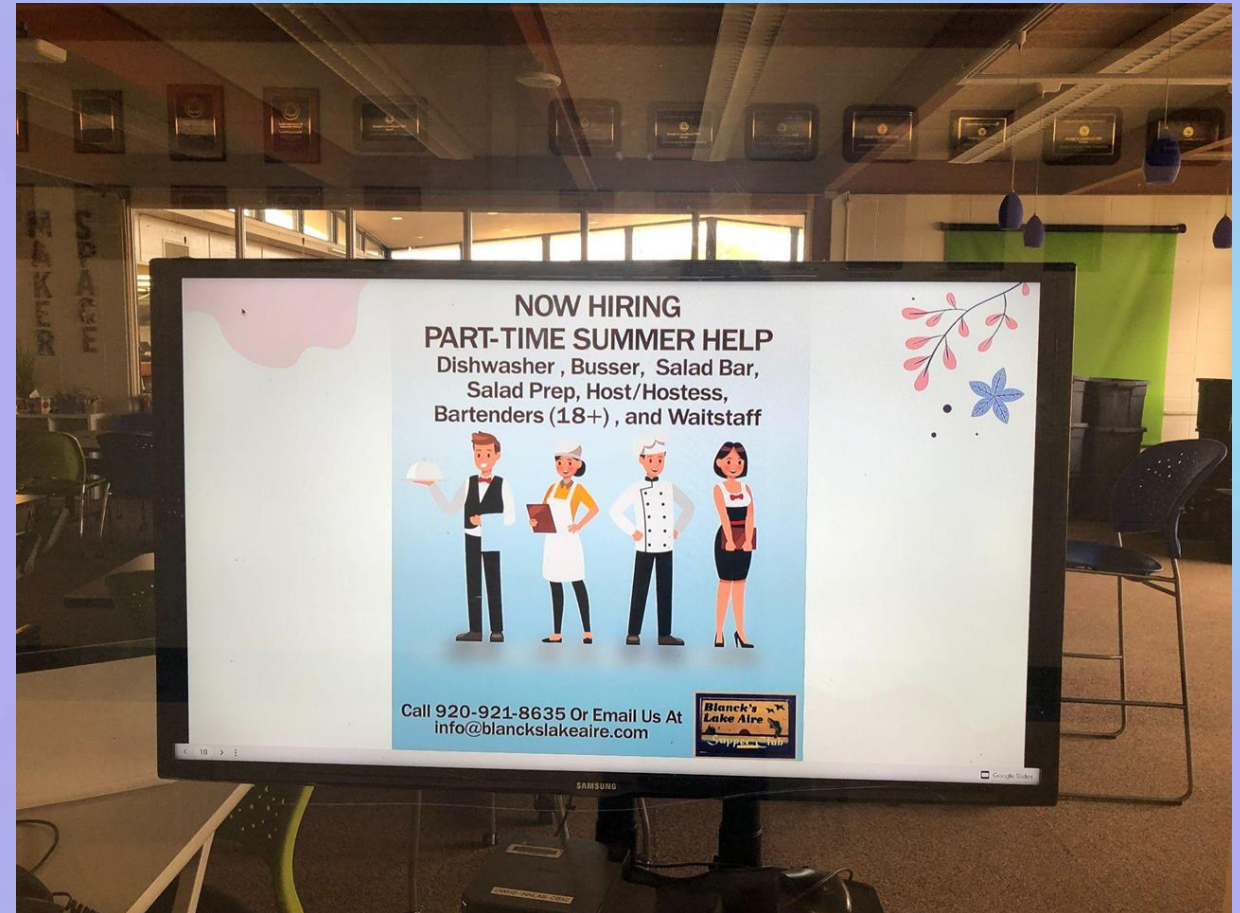
