

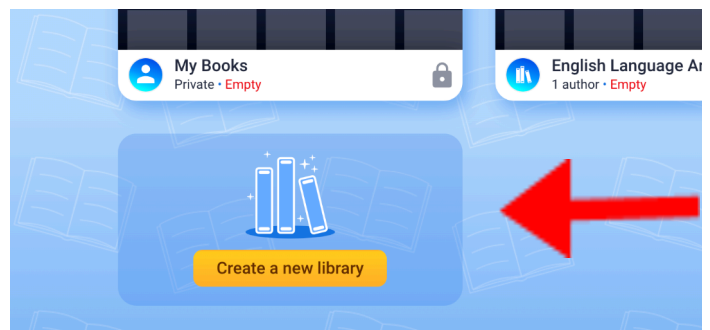
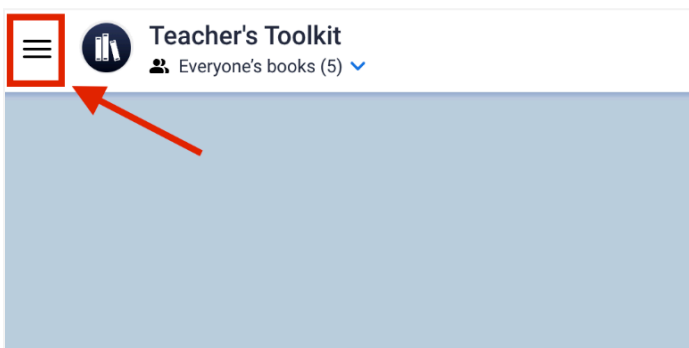
## Step-by-step instructions for using the Reading Response Journal

1. **Create a free teacher account or [log into your Book Creator teacher account](#).**

2. **Create a new library for your class** and change the settings to ensure students have a safe place to work.

To do this, go to the [Teacher Dashboard](#) (click the icon top-left of the toolbar) then choose **Create a new library**.

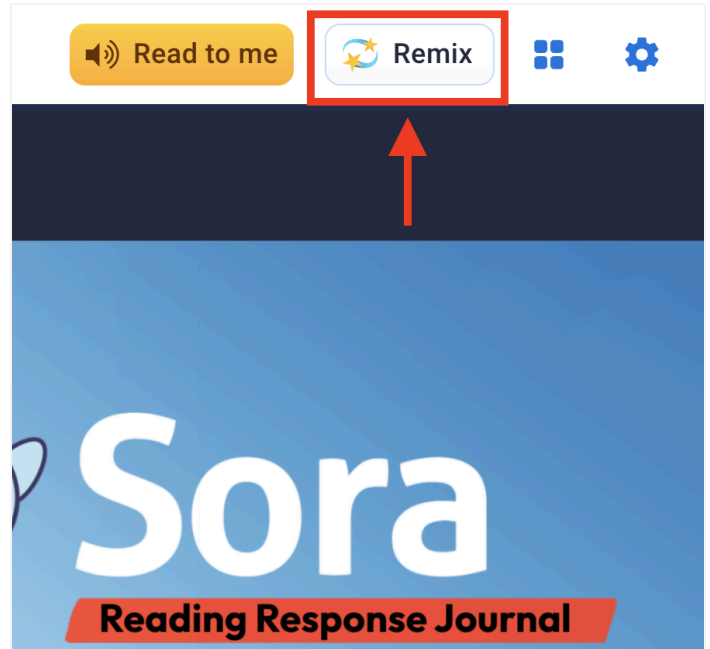
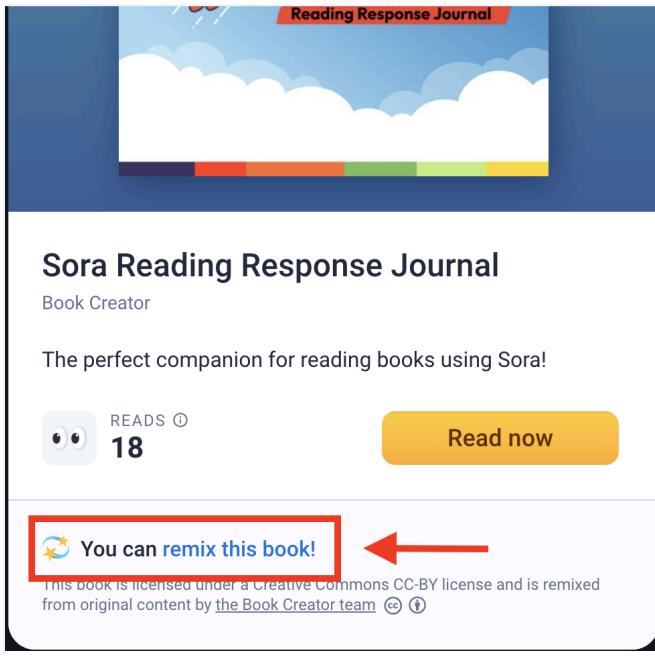


3. **Give the library a name and apply the settings that best match your needs.**

Library settings can always be changed later.

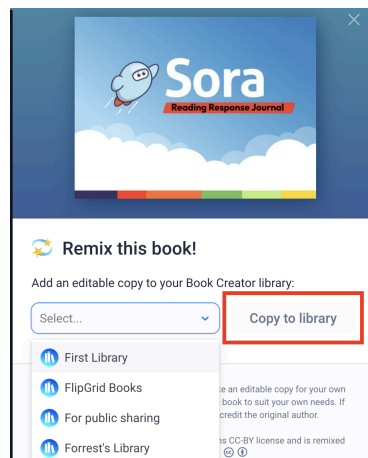
Finally, select **Create library** and you're all set to remix the Sora Reading Response Journal! [Learn more about managing Book Creator libraries](#).

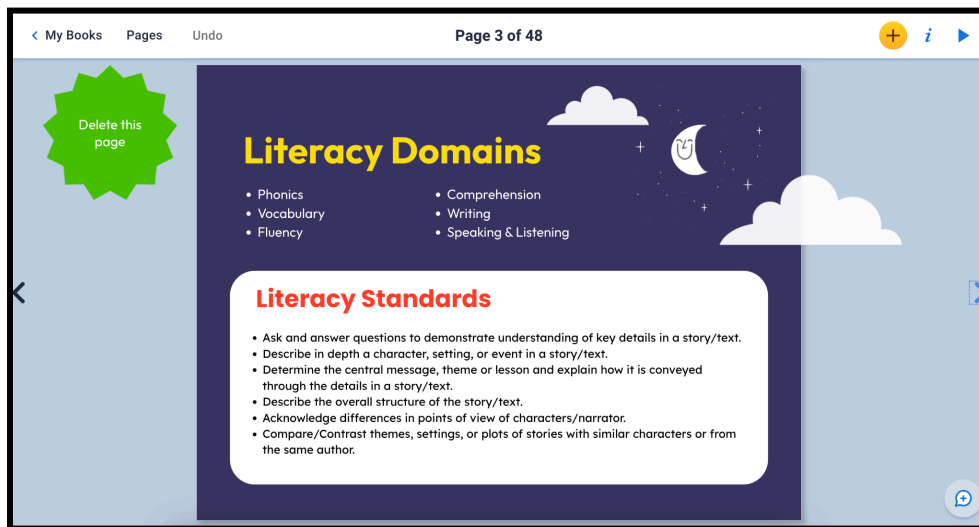




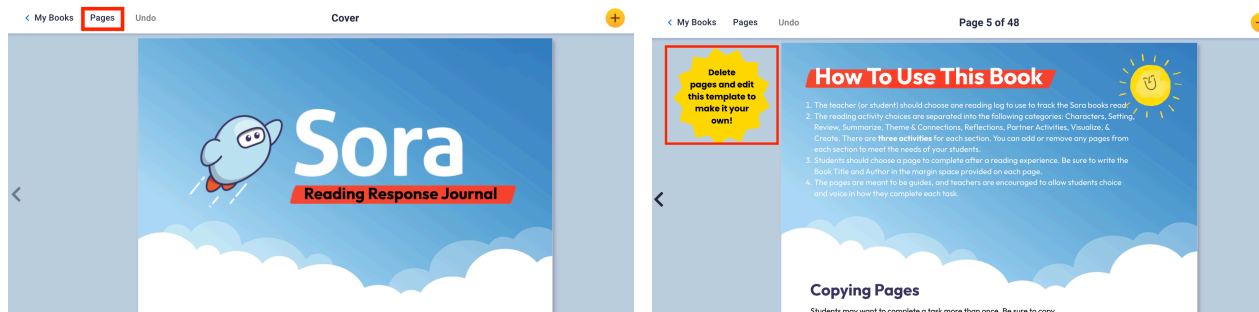

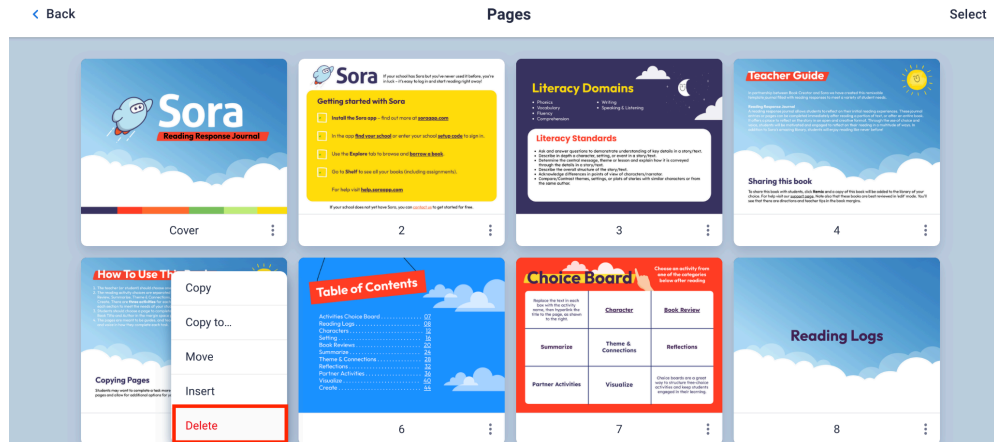

Delete pages that are marked with a note in the margin by selecting “pages.”

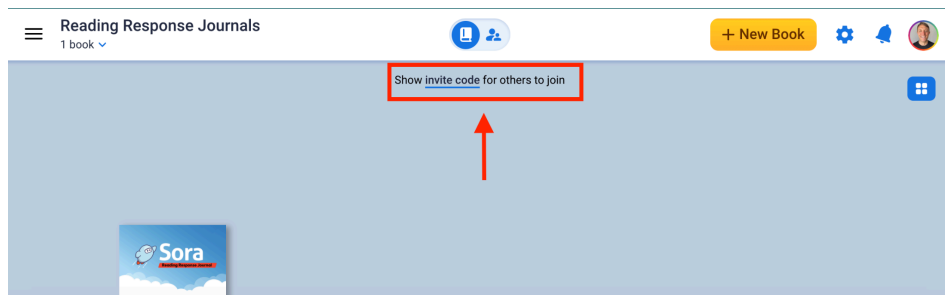


Select the 3 dots menu at the bottom of the page you want to delete and select delete.

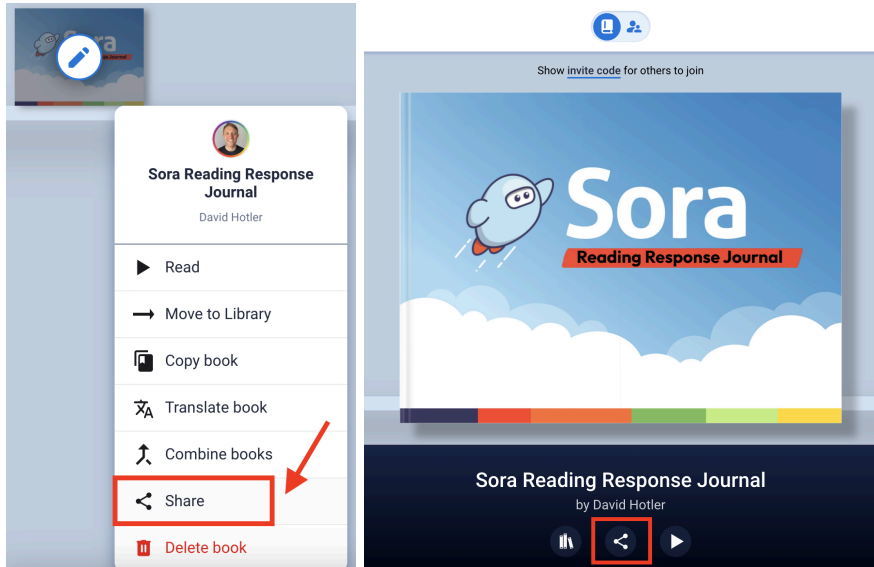


## 6. Invite students and other teachers to join the library.
